

For the past nineteen years, The Dalton Ranch Women's Golf Association and the ladies of the Glacier Club select a local charity to receive the benefits of the Columbine Classic Duet Golf Tournament. Non-profit groups submit an application to be considered and are then voted on by the members of both groups. This year the beneficiary is ***The Grief Center of Southwest Colorado.***



The Grief Center strives to offer a place of safety, comfort, and healing opportunities *to grieving children, adults, and families at little or no cost.* As a non-profit, our mission is to meet the needs of bereaved members of the community regardless of cultural and/or religious beliefs, manner of death, or relationship to the deceased *through grief counseling and unique programming such as our Children's Grief Camps and Survivors of Suicide Loss Day.*

The women also have committed to continue to support the Nick Turner Scholarship Fund that supports the Women's Varsity Golf Team at Fort Lewis College (FLC).

The Fort Lewis College Women's Varsity Golf Team is in their eighth year as a varsity sport. The Nick Turner Scholarship Fund is critical to assisting FLC coaches in recruiting players by providing them with scholarship funds. The Columbine Classic Duet Golf Tournament was able to provide the seed funding for this scholarship in 2015. In 2017, the scholarship became endowed. The Columbine Classic will continue to support and grow this fund for future FLC women golfers.
